
YouTube Audition Video Submission

Create a YouTube/Gmail account

1. Record a video meeting the audition criteria, no longer than 3 minutes in length.
2. Go to youtube.com and sign in    
3. Log in using your Gmail credentials. If you do not have a gmail account, follow the steps in




If using a computer to upload the video:

4. Click the upload button    
5. Change the settings to **Unlisted** (*Unlisted means only those with the link can access your video. It will not be public or searchable*)
6. Select and upload (or drag and drop) the video file from your document
7. Title the video using the following format:

8. Click **Publish**
9. Copy your YouTube video link, and paste it in the body of an e-mail it to summermusic@syso.org
10. In the subject line, include “Last name, First name- Instrument- Session #”
(example: Doe, John- Violin- Session II)

If using a phone/tablet:

4. Download the YouTube app
5. When the video on your phone is selected, select the share icon 
6. Share to the YouTube app
7. Log in using your Gmail credentials
8. Title the video using the following format:
“Last name, First name- Instrument- Session #” *(example: Doe, John- Violin- Session II)*
9. Change the settings to **Unlisted** *(Unlisted means only those with the link can access your video. It will not*

be public or searchable)

10. **Publish** video
11. Click the share icon and compose an e-mail to summermusic@syso.org
